# FMAP Background and Purpose

**How?** Needs identified in CVFPP, funded through 2018 Budget Act, with annual appropriations through CA Legislature.

**What?** Provide additional funding for maintenance activities to LMAs.

**Why?** To work towards sustainable O&M practices.

# FMAP Requirements

Must submit a **Proposal Solicitation Package (PSP)** for each annual appropriation.

LMA must commit to the pursuit of **USACE LOI and SWIF** and secure sufficient funding for these objectives.

New **OMRR&R Assurance Agreement** required (between LMA and CVFPB).

New **Funding Agreement** required (between LMA and DWR).



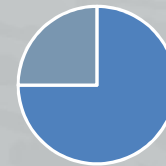
# FMAP Funding Approach

**(1)** DWR to fund LMA \$20K for LOI/SWIF preparation.

**(2)** DWR to fund LMA \$20K with LMA to secure sufficient O&M funds to perform the requirements of:

- CFR
- USACE O&M
- New OMRR&R Agreement (such as the engineering report required in preparation for a 218 Election)

**(3)** DWR to provide matching funds for O&M activities based on participation in (1) and (2).



75% match for first \$10K/mile



50% match for >\$10K/mile

LMAs may use funding from (1) and (2) for O&M activities if they already have them in place.

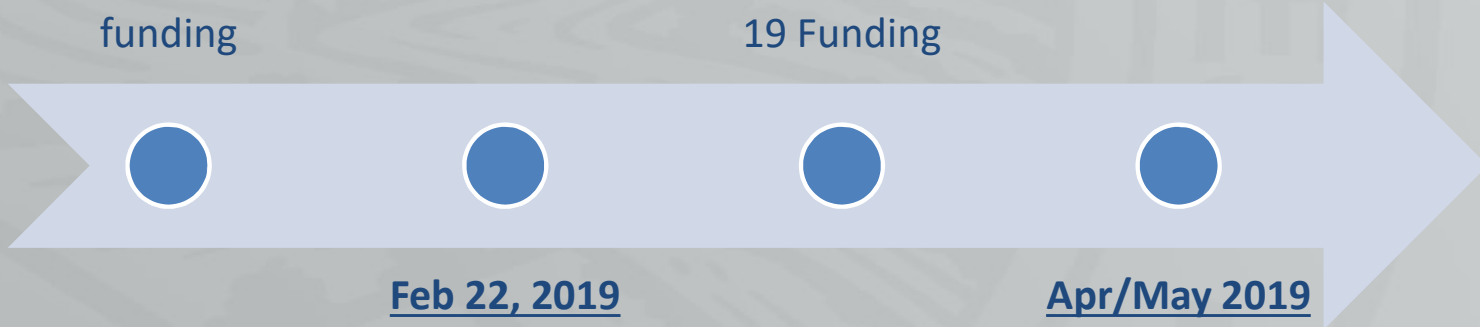
