

# FORUM35

Forum 35's Public Education Project (PEP) is an initiative of its Service Pillar designed to provide an area school with young professional volunteers for a year-long service partnership. The goal is for Forum 35's membership base to support opportunities to enhance the school environment and provide resources and opportunities for students.

To qualify for PEP, the school must be:

- A public charter or traditional public school
- In Baton Rouge, Louisiana
- Serve predominantly low-income students

The partnership will include the following provided by Forum 35 access to young professional volunteers who are eager to help your school with school events, fairs, field trips, school renovation projects, etc.

Successful applicants will include:

- Descriptive answers regarding partnership opportunities
- Descriptive answers regarding potential activities the school wants
- Application submitted by May 24, 2019

Applications are judged by a panel of members from Forum 35's Public Education Project committee. Applications are judged blind – all contact information is removed prior to judging.

**Three applicants will be selected from this application process for interview with the PEP committee.**

Final selection for our 2019-2020 School Partnership will occur in May 2019.
