- 1) Roll Call, housekeeping, attendance will be taken from the Teams meeting. Welcome to first time attendees. Please email alison.sanders@rangerconstruction.com if it is your first meeting.
- 2) Subcommittee updates

- a) Resource Development
 - i) Who will be admins/ content monitors?
 - (1) Phillip Russell, Leonard Stone, Steve Thomas, Mandy Kustra, and Jamie Bertoch will start.
 - (2) Once page is updated/completed, Heather will share it through the FTBA's main page to help increase followers.
 - (3) Admins will be content moderators. Goal is to keep the focus on leadership, training, and sharing of relevant content in safety.
- b) Technology
 - i) Jobsite security
 - (1) Vosker Remote Area Monitoring
 - (a) Solar Powered, weather resistant, with 4G LTE connectivity (SIM card), also has slot for micro-SD card.
 - (b) Both models have night vision, one model has GPS tracking. Motion detection for vehicles, people, etc...
 - (2) Robinson Boucan introduced Malik Laouadi with Vosker and played a video clip to demonstrate the product. Link www.vosker.com.
 - (a) Jamie asked Malik if the video is transmitted, and alerts are received in real-time.
 - (i) Yes, alerts and video are transmitted live.
 - (b) Can it be monitored on a cell phone and laptop?
 - (i) Yes, there is an App for cell phones and tablets and can also be monitored via laptop.
 - (c) Mandy asked about who is able to monitor the footage.
 - (i) Malik explained that whoever owns the account monitors the video.
 - (d) Mandy asked if you can zoom in.
 - (i) Malik explained that the footage is transmitted in lower resolution, but the full resolution version can be requested if the user needs to see more detail.
 - (e) Rex asked about the storage capacity of the camera.
 - (i) Everything is stored on the SD card in full HD. Cloud storage can also be purchased.
 - (f) FTBA members will get a discount off the advertised prices.
 - (g) Robinson demonstrated the 300 model in front of in-person attendees.
 - (h) Malik added that the more advanced model also does time lapse video. Good for marketing videos to create video showing phases of construction.
