* The decision of which personnel are at Middle Management and so on is at the discretion of the agency's chief official.

- Those in Command Staff or General Staff roles during an incident
- Completed ICS 100, 200, and 300

FIRE/HAZMAT:

OTHER COUNTY DEPARTMENTS:

Dept. Heads & their designees with EOC responsibilities: IS-700, IS-800, ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, ICS-400 (Sheriff, Health & Human Services/Public Health, Finance, Human Resources, Highway, MIS, Planning/GIS, Maintenance, Corp Counsel, Communication Center)

VOLUNTARY AGENCIES ACTIVE IN DISASTER:

Those with an emergency response role: IS-700, ICS-100

Those with EOC responsibilities: IS-700, ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, ICS-400

Volunteer personnel would include: Traditional volunteer organizations (i.e. Red Cross, Salvation Army), amateur radio, auxiliary police, CERT team members, VIPS volunteers)

SCHOOLS:

Administrative Staff & those involved in emergency activities: IS-700

Those with planning responsibilities: IS-800

HOSPITALS:

Those with EOC responsibilities: IS-700, ICS-100, ICS-200, ICS-300, ICS-400

OTHERS:

Support Personnel: IS-700, ICS-100

(Valley Transit)

ICS HOURS REQUIRED: Keep in mind ICS 700, 100, and 200 can be completed online. ICS 300 and 400 are required to be delivered classroom style.

700/100 = 4 Hours

200 = 2 Hours (With Exercise 4 hours)

300 = 16 hours with exercise required

400 = 16 hours with exercise required
