VIRTUAL ROLE-PLAY CONVERSATIONS: TEACHING SKILLS TO STRENGTHEN THE CULTURE OF CARE ON CAMPUSES

COVID-19 has negatively impacted 80% of students' mental health, with 20% reporting a significant deterioration. As institutions prepare for a full reopening in Fall 2021, there has been an emphasis on mental health training to strengthen campuses' culture of care.

GICA is co-hosting a webinar with Kognito on July 15 at 11:30 a.m. to discuss how virtual role-play training can teach gatekeeper, resiliency, and self-empowerment skills. The presenters will share the innovative approach and learning model geared to upskill faculty, staff, and students to support others experiencing psychological distress. Additionally, outcome data will be shared showing significant increases in preparedness and confidence leading to behavioral change.

The presenters include Dr. Darren Jones, Manager of Strategic Initiatives & Partnerships at Kognito and Dr. Glenn Albright from the Department of Psychology at Baruch College in City University of New York.

TITLE IX TRAINING - OVERVIEW LIVE AND RECORDED WEBINARS
