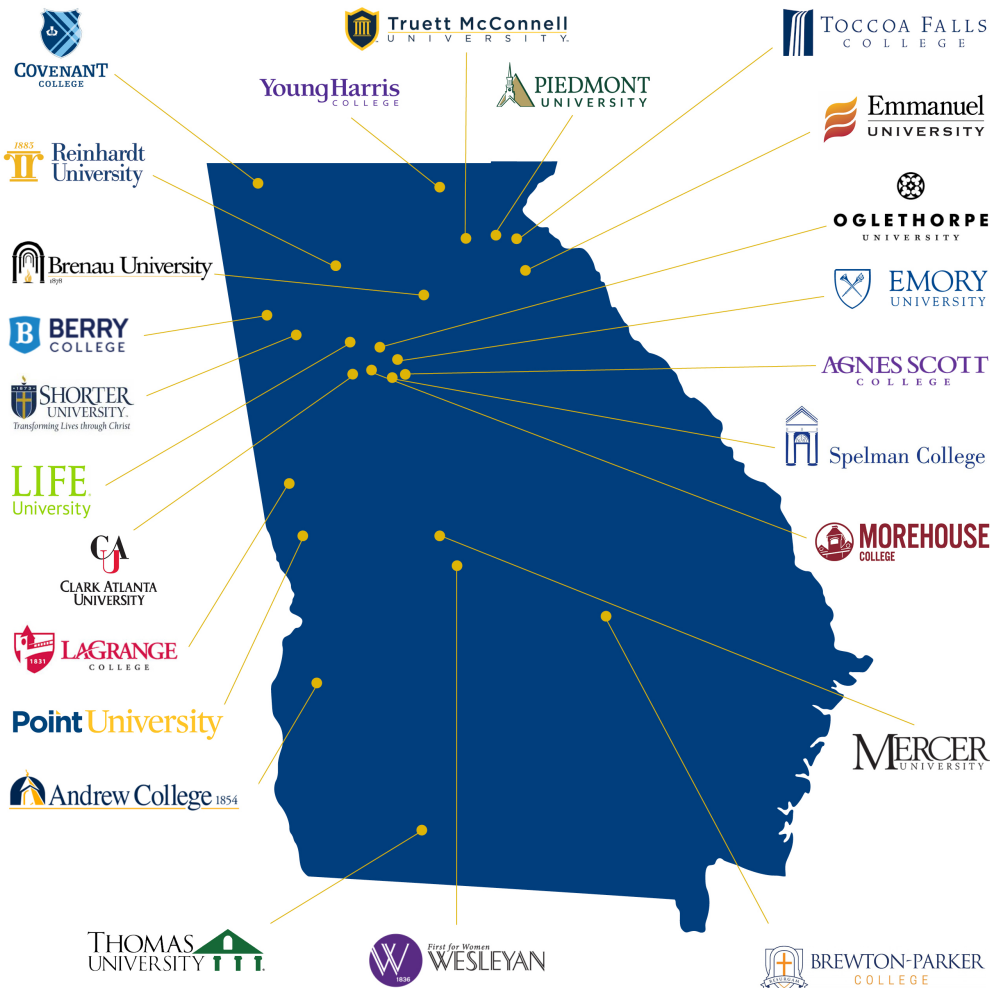

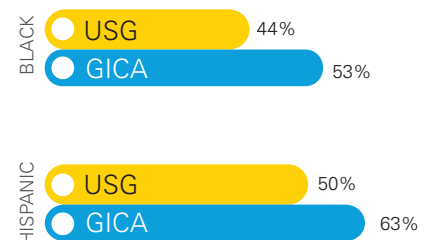

# GICA Highlights

## Enrollment

- \* GICA institutions enrolled 74,586 students in 2022-2023, of which 53,833 were undergraduates.
- \* GICA institutions enrolled 63,500 students in Fall 2022, of which 45,793 were undergraduates.
- \* From 2012 to 2022, undergraduate enrollment in GICA member institutions increased by 12%.
- \* The student body at GICA member institutions is diverse: 53% report being a student of color, 61% are female, 10% of undergraduates are adult learners, and 18% of undergraduates attend part-time.

## Financial Aid

- \* In 2022-2023, 8,823 students received the HOPE Scholarship award, 3,084 students received the State's Zell Miller Scholarship award, and 17,557 students received the State's Tuition Equalization Grant. More than \$54 million in HOPE/Zell scholarship funds were awarded and just over \$14 million in TEG funds were distributed.
- \* The average net price of attendance for students receiving grant or scholarship aid at GICA four-year member institutions in 2021-2022 was \$23,338. Net price is the total cost of attendance after grants and scholarships are taken into account.
- \* 89% first-time, full-time students attending GICA member institutions receive some form of financial aid.
- \* The total aid awarded to first-time, full-time freshmen in 2021-2022 was \$252,623,854.
- \* GICA institutions awarded \$163,765,340 in institutional grant aid to first-time, full-time freshmen 2021-2022. This represents more than half (65%) of the total aid awarded to students. The average amount of institutional grant aid awarded to students at 4-year institutions ranged from \$5,549 to \$46,482.
- \* Nearly half of all undergraduates are recipients of the Pell grant with the typical award amount ranging from \$2,408 to \$5,798 per student.

## Completions

- \* Over 15,000 degrees were awarded by GICA member institutions in 2022-2023.
- \* Georgia's independent colleges and universities had higher graduation rates for their students compared to the State's public institutions. Fifty-two percent of students at GICA institutions graduated within 4 years compared to 33% of students at Georgia public colleges, and 7% of students at Georgia's for-profit colleges.
- \* GICA member institutions awarded 891 Associate's Degrees, 7,880 Bachelor's Degrees, 4,450 Master's Degrees, and 1,803 Doctoral Degrees in 2022-2023.
- \* Since 2012-2013, the percentage of Bachelor's degrees awarded at GICA member institutions increased 6%, Master's degrees increased 26%, and the number of Doctoral degrees awarded also increased 26%.
