

#### **GICA Highlights**

#### **Enrollment**

- \* GICA institutions enrolled 71,460 students in 2021-2022, of which 50,967 were undergraduates.
- \* GICA institutions enrolled 62,121 students in Fall 2021, of which 44,576 were undergraduates.
- \* From 2011 to 2021, enrollment in GICA member institutions increased by 9%.
- \* The student body at GICA member institutions is diverse: 53% report being a student of color, 61% are female, 10% of undergraduates are adult learners, and 18% of undergraduates attend part-time.

#### Financial Aid

- \* In 2021-2022, 9,067 students received the HOPE Scholarship award, over 3,100 received the State's Zell Miller Scholarship award, and nearly 18,000 received the State's Tuition Equalization Grant. More than \$53 million in HOPE/Zell scholarship funds were awarded and just under \$14 million in TEG funds were distributed.
- \* The average net price of attendance for students receiving grant or scholarship aid at GICA four-year member institutions in 2020-2021 was \$21,871. Net price is the total cost of attendance after grants and scholarships are taken into account.
- \* Nearly all students attending GICA member institutions receive some form of financial aid. The total aid awarded to first-time, full-time freshmen in 2020-2021 was \$230,137,507.
- \* GICA institutions awarded \$147,964,551 in institutional grant aid to first-time, full-time freshmen 2020-2021. This represents more than half (63%) of the total aid awarded to students. The average amount of institutional grant aid awarded to students at 4-year institutions ranged from \$6,760 to \$41,681.
- \* Nearly half of all undergraduates are recipients of the Pell grant with the typical award amount ranging from \$3,298 to \$5,833 per student.

#### Completions

- \* Over 15,000 degrees were awarded by GICA member institutions in 2021-2022.
- \* Georgia's independent colleges and universities had higher graduation rates for their students compared to the State's public institutions. Fifty percent of students at GICA institutions graduated within 4 years compared to 32% of students at Georgia public colleges, and 4% of students at Georgia's for-profit colleges.
- \* GICA member institutions awarded 703 Associate's Degrees, 8,563 Bachelor's Degrees, 4,031 Master's Degrees, and 1,807 Doctoral Degrees in 2021-2022.
- \* Since 2011, the percentage of Master's degrees awarded at GICA member institutions increased 22%, and the number of Doctoral degrees awarded increased 37%.
