



GRPA Annual Conference October 5-7 Athens Safety Protocols



GRPA is committed to following protocols, including sanitation, mask-wearing, and other safety measures to offer an environment that encourages safety for your conference experience. GRPA will follow all current Executive Orders from the Governor, measures enforced by Athens-Clarke County, and CDC and DPH guidelines. GRPA advises that you NOT attend conference if: You have tested positive for COVID-19, are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, or have had close contact with a person who has had symptoms of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

Safety Precautions

- Temperature Checks will be performed each day when coming into the Classic Center
- Following CDC guidelines, a temperature of 100.4 or higher constitutes a fever, and any individual registering a temperature of 100.4 or higher will not be allowed into the area and will be provided protocols for quarantining.
- Facemasks will be mandatory while in the Classic Center
- Touchless check-in at conference. Attendees will have their bags and shirts at separate tables upon check-in.
- Water bottle, facemasks, sanitizer, and shirt will be provided in each welcome conference bag
- Session check-in will be done by app only. QR codes will be located throughout the meeting rooms
- Exhibit hall vendors will be in 10 X 12 booths with maximum 2 representatives
- One way routes down isles will be indicated by floor markings
- Food and beverage will be very limited and prepackaged

Classic Center Precautions

- All meeting rooms will be set at social distancing guidelines
- Meeting rooms will be cleaned between sessions
- Restrooms will be monitored and cleaned as sessions are going on
- Separate traffic flows in the hallways will be used
- Touchless water fountains will be located throughout the facility to fill water bottles
- Hand sanitizing stations will be provided throughout the facility
- Entire facility will be completely disinfected each evening
