IACP Position Statement

Provider Status for Pharmacists

The International Academy of Compounding Pharmacists supports the Vision Statement adopted by the Joint Commission of Pharmacy Practitioners (JCPP) in November 2013 which emphasizes the critical role that pharmacists serve in providing patients with medication management care:

Patients achieve optimal health and medication outcomes with pharmacists as essential and accountable providers within patient-centered, team-based healthcare.

To assure that all patients have access to much-needed pharmacist services, IACP supports changes to federal laws and regulations that provide for coverage of those services to patients enrolled in federally funded health programs. Specifically, IACP supports a legislative objective to:

Amend section 1861 of the Social Security Act for Medicare coverage of pharmacist services furnished by a pharmacist for medically underserved populations, as licensed by State law, which the pharmacist is legally authorized to perform in the State in which the individual performs such services to be paid at 85 percent of the physician fee schedule and the Secretary develops pharmacist specific codes as part of the physician fee schedule to serve as the basis for payment of pharmacist services.
