



Q: Can I still register for the Virtual Symposium?

A: Registration is now closed, but if you would like to register you can contact us at iaedpsymposium2020@gmail.com. Please note – the symposium CLOSES August 3rd. If you are interested in the core courses (for [Certification](#) or [Educational Designation](#)) you can take them online. Registration for the 2021 Symposium will open this Fall.

Q: How long will the Virtual Symposium be open?

A: The Symposium will remain open through the end of the business day, Monday, August 3, 2020.

Q: How many CE's can I earn through the Virtual Symposium?

A: You can earn a maximum of 28 CE's, but may watch as many sessions as you wish.

Q: How do I know how many CEs I'll earn for each session?

A: There is a Session Information and Disclosure form included in each session which provides the number of CEs. Roughly, this is based on 1 CE per hour of session, so if a session is 90 minutes it would be worth 1.5 CEs.

Q: How do I get CE's for the core courses if I am not already signed up for them?

A: You will need to add them to your symposium registration (fee is \$250). Please email iaedpsymposium2020@gmail.com if you would like to do this.

Q: How do I collect CE's?

- Watch the session in its entirety, including any Q&A at the end
- Complete and pass the quiz located in each individual session
- Complete the session evaluation located in each individual session
- When you are finished collecting CE's, complete the final evaluation survey located in the Symposium Lobby under Resources. Select ONLY the sessions for which you want to earn CE's, not for all sessions watched.

Q: How long will it take to get my CE Certificate?

A: CE certificates will be sent via email about 2 weeks after you complete the final evaluation.

Q: How many CE's is each session worth?

A: Each session has a Session Information and Disclosure PDF in the resources widget where you can see how many CE's are offered for that particular session. These CEs are based on the viewing time for each session.

Q: Is there a way for me to track on my own how many CE's I've earned?

A: Unfortunately, the system does not have the capability for users to track activities completed or sessions viewed. We recommend keeping your own record.
