- Education and Training
- Set Policy
- Hire staff
- Full support of existing codes



Education & Training

- Education is provided free
- Need location for training
- Will provide specialized custom training
- Provide ongoing technical support
- Onsite training
- One on one training
- **Trained staff are efficient staff**



Setting Policy

- Minimum Codes and Standards
- Set minimum annual education requirements for staff
