

## Submission Guidelines and Selection Criteria

### **Presenter Criteria:**

- 1. The Presenter(s) must be an IITAP member in good standing as an ASAT, CSAT, ACBRT, CCBRT, APTT, CPTT, CSAT Supervisor, CSAT/CPTT Supervisor, PSAP, PSAP Supervisor, or a CSAT/CPTT/CCBRT/PSAP Candidate.**
- 2. Presenter(s) must be available to present at any time during the Symposium (April 23, 24, 25 2026) \*Note that consideration will be given to accommodate religious observance\***
- 3. The Primary Presenter is the primary contact person and is responsible for notifying all other presenters of acceptance, scheduling, and any other information requested by IITAP**

### **Presentations Selection Criteria:**

- 1. Presentation relevance and how it supports the needs and current trends within the fields of compulsive sexual behavior and/or trauma treatment and the task material.**
- 2. Expertise & experience of the presenter as related to their identified presentation topic.**
- 3. Originality and applicability of the material to the IITAP community.**
- 4. Quality of the learning objectives and information gained for attendees.**
- 5. Categories of topics for consideration can include Diversity, Ethics, Addiction Interaction, Use of IITAP assessments, tasks, performables, etc.**
- 6. Content must appeal to a diverse and broad spectrum of attendees.**
