Exhibitor Guidelines

Table Assignments

Table assignments will be determined by IITAP and communicated to exhibitors before the symposium.

Exhibit Hall Information

- Complimentary wireless internet access will be available in the exhibit area.
- A finalized exhibit-hall diagram, including table placements, will be provided once available.

Sales and Transactions

Exhibitors are prohibited from engaging in sales or financial transactions at their booths. This includes:

- **No sale of goods or services:** Exhibitors may not sell products or services during the event. Books and workbooks must be sold through the IITAP bookstore.
- **No exchange of money:** No money, checks, credit cards, electronic payments, or other forms of payment may be accepted at the booth.
- **No exchange of goods:** Exhibitors may not exchange goods for compensation, including bartering or trade.

This policy supports a consistent experience for attendees and compliance with event requirements. Exhibitors are encouraged to distribute informational materials, conduct demonstrations, and engage with attendees in a non-commercial manner.

IMPORTANT: Failure to follow these guidelines may result in the immediate removal of the exhibitor booth without a refund.

Symposium Registration

One symposium registration is included with each exhibitor booth. All additional booth representatives must register independently through [IITAP.com/event/2027](https://iitap.com/event/2027). Symposium access and continuing-education eligibility are subject to IITAP's standard registration and attendance requirements.

Booth Staffing & Promotional Materials

- Exhibitors are responsible for staffing their booths during the published exhibit hours.
- Informational materials and non-commercial demonstrations are permitted.
- Food, giveaways, drawings, displays, and signage must comply with IITAP and venue requirements. Submit special requests to IITAP in advance.

Shipping, Electricity & Venue Services

- Do not ship exhibit materials until IITAP provides the applicable venue shipping and delivery instructions.
- Electricity and other venue services must be arranged in advance when needed. Additional venue fees may apply.

Symposium App Listing

Each exhibitor receives a digital organization listing in the 2027 IITAP Symposium App. IITAP will provide the submission deadline for the organization name, logo, website, and 50-word description with the exhibitor confirmation materials.

Reservation, Payment & Confirmation

Exhibit space is confirmed only after IITAP approves the completed reservation form and receives full payment. Payment instructions and the applicable cancellation/refund terms will be included in the exhibitor invoice or confirmation materials.
