Since 1988, Prescott House has provided unparalleled services to men and their family, both nationally and internationally. Throughout the years, we have found that long-term recovery is best achieved through long-term treatment, in a nurturing and therapeutic environment.

Every individual in the Prescott House will participate in over 18 hours of group therapy weekly. Individuals will also be assigned a primary therapist with whom they will have daily group sessions, and weekly individual sessions.

Prescott House is committed to providing excellent clinical care in a close-knit recovery community. This commitment is founded on a firm belief in recovery of the mind, spirit, and body.

Prescott House is a safe environment in which individuals may confront their self-destructive behaviors and develop integrity and accountability, while nurturing their personal and emotional growth in recovery.

As a staff we work tirelessly and implement a holistic approach to treat the causes of self-destructive behaviors, and not simply the symptoms.

Community Based Recovery

Our program is community-oriented, and individuals attend local recovery meetings on a daily basis. They will also work with a recovery sponsor and become part of a larger recovery community, and develop strong friendships within the Prescott House program as well. They will practice self-sustaining behavior in our residential suites, purchasing their own groceries, and preparing their own meals. Our therapeutic model is community-based, utilizing group therapy, family-of-origin therapy, and advanced educational groups. The community model has been proven invaluable in helping clients grow through having a safe place to process individualistic, real-life experiences.

Program Offerings

Prescott House is an Arizona state-licensed extended care treatment facility for men. Our program provides intensive treatment for addiction and mental health for men who are striving for higher function in their lives.

Individuals may choose to embark on our 90 day track, which encompasses the full scope of our therapeutic care, culminating with a family session to renew bonds and restore harmony within the family unit.

Our more traditional full stay 6-month residential program is a more long-term comprehensive approach to sustainable recovery. Our full program addresses every facet of a transition to independence, including building and maintaining a strong support network.

Individuals in the program will receive nuanced instructional care in obtaining employment or schooling; and creating sustainable behaviors around nutrition, exercise, and managing financial affairs. We aim to foster independence and provide outpatient care to our outbound clients who have transitioned to independent living.
