1 Log In to Consortium Connect

Sign Into Our New Membership Management Portal

Sign Into the New Consortium Connect

The Username and Password that you've just created will be utilized on both our Membership Management Portal and Consortium Connect.

While signed into the Membership Management Portal, navigate to the Consortium Connect URL: <https://connect.imconsortium.org/home>

You will be automatically signed into our Community website, or you'll need to click the Log In button. If you see a popup to "Access Your Profile" accept that message by clicking "Submit."
