



The ICAEF Scholarships

The International Caterers Association Educational Foundation is a not-for-profit foundation created to provide educational opportunities to professional caterers worldwide. It was established to foster the advancement of ICA member firms, in their knowledge of the catering and hospitality industry, as well as the development of sound business practices.

The Foundation makes it possible for qualified individuals including owners, managers and employees of member firms, to attend designated educational conferences in connection with the International Caterers Association. The Catersource Conference and Tradeshow is scheduled for March 8-11, 2015 in Las Vegas.

Scholarships are awarded based on merit. The criteria includes that the firm must be a member of the ICA for at least one year prior to submission by conference date. Up to two (2) applications per member firm may be submitted for each conference. All information is kept confidential and only the name of the recipient and the company name will be released. The value of the scholarship is the FULL COST OF TUITION for the conference. (Package does not include social functions – those are the responsibility of the recipient.) Candidate is responsible for their own expenses including transportation, lodging, meals, etc.

Application Procedure:

The scholarship application must be submitted as a complete document and include:

1. Merit based scholarship application from the individual of a member firm. The application must be completed in its entirety and emailed **on or prior to November 1st**.
2. Typed personal essay up to three pages by the applicant.
3. Supporting recommendation letters.

Selection of Scholarship Recipients:

All applications will be reviewed by a non-partial committee based on criteria developed from the Scholarship Committee of ICAEF, administered by the Arizona Community Foundation.

Selection will be based on several criteria:

- Measurable accomplishments of the individual that would constitute a major contribution to the sponsoring company or the industry in general.
- Consideration of awards, recognitions, published articles, and professional activities outside of company.
- Content of the personal essay indicating career intent for the catering/hospitality industry and why applicant believes they are deserving of this merit scholarship.
- Supporting recommendation letters.

We highly recommend that you submit your application and supplemental letters in the same email to ensure your complete application is considered. Once received by ACF, you will receive a confirmation email. If you do not receive this, you may email scholarship@azfoundation.org to verify that we have received your complete application.

All applications and supporting documents become the property of the ICAEF and will not be returned. Only fully completed applications with the original supporting documents received by email on or before the published deadline date for submission will be considered.

Members of the **ICAEF Board** and their staff members are NOT eligible for scholarships.

Members of the **ICA Board** and their staff members ARE eligible for scholarships.

- Will you be held accountable by your company to make recommendations and how will the results of the recommendations be measured?
- How do you see your future in the catering field?
- List your Professional Accomplishments relating to the current employing company constituting cost savings, innovation, creativity and/or leadership that has benefited the company or industry.
- List your awards, recognitions, published articles, and professional activities outside of company.

Award Terms & Conditions:

- If you leave the employment of your company prior to the conference, the scholarship will be rescinded.
- If your company is no longer in operation, we reserve the right to cancel this scholarship.
- All winners will automatically be an ICA ambassador. Each winner will be assigned a specific duty during the conference. This will not take away your time during the educational programs of the conference.
- You acknowledge that you are responsible for securing and paying for you own travel and entertainment including but not limited to: ground transportation, lodging, meals, etc.
- **All winners must submit an essay** to ICAEF post-conference outlining what receiving this scholarship meant to you and about your experience at Catersource 2015 **no later than March 30, 2015**. (Summary shall be no less than 300 words and be typed pages. This may be used for marketing purposes.)
