Who does the **BEYA STEM** Conference serve?

The demographic shift forces diversity initiatives to be priority for organi-

The changing demographics of the workforce is adversely impacting the labor pool making diversity recruitment and retention efforts important.

According to the BLS Employment Outlook 2010-2020

- Hispanic and Asian labor force will grow by 25% and 21% res-pectively
- African-American labor force will grow by just 3% and white men's will decrease by more than 8%
- By 2020, the labor force will be 67% women and minorities and 33% white men

According to the American Society for Engineering Education

- 68% of all undergraduate engineering students in the U.S. are white, and just over 5% are African-American
- African-Americans in STEM occupations stands at just 6.2%, much less the 10.7% share of the entire U.S. workforce in 2004.



Several studies show a strong correlation between recognition and retention

• U.S. Department of Labor cites lack of appreciation as the number one reason employees leave their iobs



- > 55% are men and 45% are women 70% of attendees are professionals.
- > 50% of the professionals are in engineering related field.
- > 5% hold a science related field. 12 % are in management.
- > 63% of the professionals attending hold a degree at or above the master's level (13% are Ph.D.'s).
- > 71% have been with their employers for more than 5 years.
- > 30% are college students and postgraduates
- 51% seeking immediate employment (seniors and post graduates)
- 20% seeking internships
- 85% have a GPA of a "B" or better




