

ISHR-NAS is pleased to announce the availability of **Early Career Investigator (ECI) Travel Awards** for travel to the ISHR-North American Section meeting in Halifax, NS, Canada (May 29 – June 1, 2018).

Awards will be for a total of \$500 USD and will be given to support travel expenses associated with the meeting.

Requirements for the ECI awards:

- Each applicant must be a **paid member** of an ISHR Section by March 15, 2018 (Applicants can join online @ www.ishrworld.org).
- Recipients must be **within 5 years of their terminal degree** at the time of the ISHR-NAS meeting (degree was, or will be, received after May 30, 2013).
- Recipients must be **first (or last) author and personally present an abstract** at the ISHR-NAS meeting.
- A **maximum of two ECI's per laboratory** can apply for travel awards and if the two are selected, the award will be split so that each successful applicant receives \$250 USD.
- As a condition of accepting this travel award, **Canadian trainees are required to join the Canadian Physiological Society** (which is providing ECI travel funds). ISHR-NAS will reimburse Canadian travel award recipients for the cost of joining CPS (\$25 CAD for students, \$65 CAD for postdocs) upon confirmation of membership.

To apply:

- Submit a **copy of your abstract** and a **letter from your supervisor** 1) confirming that you are a trainee and 2) verifying that you are within 5 years of your terminal degree to Susan Howlett and Leslie Lobaugh by **March 15, 2018**. The abstract and letter should be submitted as a **SINGLE PDF FILE** by email to BOTH ISHR-NAS Secretary, Susan Howlett (susan.howlett@dal.ca), and ISHR Exec Sec, Leslie Lobaugh (llobaugh@nc.rr.com).
