Visiting Assistant Professor/Instructor, Fashion Program

The College of Creative Arts: The College of Creative Arts seeks applications for a Visiting Assistant Professor/Instructor to teach in a new and growing interdisciplinary Fashion Program. The successful candidate will be a dynamic and passionate educator and fashion enthusiast who excels in a collaborative and collegial environment. The position is primarily a teaching position and requires the ability to teach some or all of the following classes: Introduction to the Fashion Industry, Fashion Design Elements and Principles, Textiles for Fashion, Contemporary Fashion History, Fashion Illustration, Fashion (technical drawing) and Digital Tools. This faculty member will also be expected to advise students and engage in service to the department, division, university and/or community at large. This appointment is a non-tenure-eligible 9-month appointment with benefits. The appointment may be recommended for additional one-year terms up to 5 years, depending on funding and satisfactory performance.

Require: Earned Master's in Fashion or related area with applied experience (for appointment as Instructor); MFA or other relevant terminal degree (for appointment as Visiting Assistant Professor). Position is not eligible for H1B sponsorship.

Desire: MFA or other relevant terminal degree; demonstrated experience as an exceptional teacher at the undergraduate level; previous experience with curriculum development and innovative initiatives; industry experience strongly preferred.
