The Department of Human Ecology at the State University of New York College at Oneonta invites applications for a tenure track position as an Assistant Professor of Fashion and Textiles with a focus in Design beginning Fall 2019. The initial appointment will be for two years. Expectations include teaching, research, student advisement, college service, and continuing professional development. Located in the hills of Central New York, SUNY Oneonta is a mid-size, public, liberal arts and sciences college with a pre-professional focus. The College enrolls approximately 6,000 students in a wide variety of bachelor's degree programs and a number of graduate certificates and degrees. The College sits at #13 on the 2018 list of "Top Public Regional Universities" in the North published by U.S. News & World Report and is ranked #166 in the Northeast on the Forbes magazine list of "America's Top Colleges." SUNY Oneonta received INSIGHT magazine's Higher Education Excellence in Diversity Award in 2017 and 2014, accepted an invitation to join the Colleges of Distinction in 2015, and has been included in the Princeton Review's "Guide to Green Colleges" every year since the guide's inception in 2010. The Fashion and Textiles program, housed in the Department of Human Ecology, includes an American Association of Family and Consumer Sciences (AAFCS) accredited program in Fashion and Textiles and participation in the one year Visiting Student Program with the Fashion Institute of Technology (FIT) in NYC. There are approximately 235 students in the Fashion and Textiles program with a total of 600 students and a faculty of 29 in the Department. Other majors in the Department include Child and Family Studies, Dietetics, Food Service and Restaurant Administration, General Human Ecology, and MS Nutrition and Dietetics. **Preferred:** experience teaching at the college level; prior experience in the fashion and textiles industry; experience with the use of technology in the classroom; evidence of ability to teach the subject matter specified in the position duties; evidence of scholarship, research, student advisement; experience working with diverse populations and/ or teaching pedagogies and/or multicultural teaching experience.
