

## Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

- The Acceptable Use Policy applies to all educational materials available on the ITAA Teaching Collection web pages. All contributors and users of the ITAA Teaching Collection web pages must comply.
- Educational materials are provided in the spirit of collaboration among ITAA members for the purpose of improving teaching and learning across all textile and apparel-related subjects. All materials accessible through the Teaching Collection's web pages are available only to ITAA members for personal and non-commercial use.
- The Teaching Collection uses the Intellectual Property (IP) protection policies of the Creative Commons consortium (<http://creativecommons.org>). Under Creative Commons licensing, all materials posted on the ITAA Teaching Collection web pages are freely available for ITAA members to use, without prior permission provided that users adhere to the terms of the appropriate Creative Commons license. In general, Creative Commons licenses require:
  - Attribution – Users must give attribution to the creators of IP when using materials obtained from the Teaching Collection.
  - Non-Commercial Use – Users may not use, or knowingly permit use of IP obtained from the ITAA Teaching Collection web pages for commercial purposes.
- The following are considered violations of the Acceptable Use Policy
  - Providing fee-based materials on Teaching Collection web pages.
  - Using materials available on Teaching Collection web pages to make fraudulent offers to buy or sell the Collection's educational materials.
  - Using The Collection's educational teaching and learning resources without adhering to the Creative Commons license requirements pertaining to Attribution and Non-Commercial Use.
