Research projects will explore the influence of social movements on offline and online consumption behavior using social network analysis and structural equation modeling. The research associate will assist in producing (writing, analysis, review, e.g.) several grants aimed at improving undergraduate instruction in technology classes. Additionally, the research associate will have the opportunity to teach one online course in the last semester of their appointment.</p>
