Dear Members:

We are pleased to commence the publication cycle for The Paul J. Luckern Summer Associate Edition of the ITC Trial Lawyers Association's 337 Reporter for 2019. Last year's edition contained sixteen excellent articles surveying numerous aspects of Section 337 practice, and we expect another crop of excellent submissions this year.

As you identify projects for your law firm's summer associate class, we invite you to submit an article authored by one or two of your summer associates. While we normally only allow one submission per law firm, given the unique conditions of this year's summer programs, we will allow up to two submissions per firm. Past authors have found working on a Summer Associate Edition article to be a highly rewarding experience, and receiving publication credit is a valuable opportunity. As we have in the past, the Summer Associate Edition Editorial Committee plans to recognize the best submissions at the ITCTLA Annual Meeting in November 2020.

If you would like to submit a summer associate article, please notify us of the article's topic in advance so that we can reserve it for you. Failure to do so may prevent us from publishing your article—e.g., because it concerns a previously reserved topic.

The enclosed instructions include a list of suggested topics and topics from past Summer Associate Editions; we strongly encourage articles on topics different from those addressed by recent past editions. Authors are not limited to this list, however, and may write on any topic related to Section 337, provided they obtain prior approval from the editors. The instructions outline the submission process, as well as research tips, formatting and style guidelines, and other pertinent information. We also have enclosed the winning submissions from last year's Summer Associate Edition.

The deadline to notify the editors of your selected topic is June 26, 2020. The final deadline for submissions is August 7, 2020. Please note that the editorial committee has sole discretion in accepting submissions and selecting articles for publication. We highly prioritize quality and uniqueness and do not anticipate publishing every article.
