

PPE Resources

- Amazon: The Virginia Emergency Support Team (VEST) coordinated with Amazon to ensure organizations on the frontlines of the COVID-19 response in the Commonwealth can purchase critically needed personal protective equipment (PPE) through Amazon Business on a prioritized basis. This opportunity is available to hospitals, health clinics, doctor's offices, and other medical care providers. In order to participate in this program, a business must first sign up on Amazon Business. As with many other supply chain routes, PPE supplies through Amazon are limited depending on current demand and inbound shipments. Nevertheless, this option can serve as a prioritized source of PPE for Virginia's medical providers that are experiencing disruptions in their normal supply chain.
- <u>Virginia Manufacturer's Association</u>: The Virginia Manufacturer's Association partnered with Virginia businesses to create a website that serves as a <u>clearinghouse for businesses</u> seeking PPE.
- <u>Virginia Department of General Services</u>: The Department of General Services provided <u>list of vendors</u> that are offering supplies and services geared to assist the Commonwealth with the COVID-19 pandemic.
