ADC IPC Needs Assessment

LeadingAge Virginia developed a needs assessment to determine the capabilities for Adult Day Centers to implement the grant-developed resources.

The IPC Needs Assessment allows us to:

- ❖ Better understand infection prevention practices in place at each center;
- ❖ Better understand ADC's adoption of the grant-developed model infection prevention policies and related tools;
- ❖ Better understand barriers or challenges to effective infection prevention practices in each center; and
- ❖ Align LeadingAge Virginia's resources with any observed gaps in infection prevention practices and/or challenges reported by ADCs.

- ❖ Environmental Cleaning and Disinfection
- ❖ Hand Hygiene
- ❖ Respiratory Hygiene
- ❖ Selection and Use of PPE
- ❖ Auditing and Monitoring
- ❖ Participant Care Equipment, Devices, & Supplies



Challenges and Barriers

- ❖ Frequent policy and guidance changes
- ❖ Getting participants to use handwashing stations
- ❖ Resources
- ❖ Staff + Staff Turnover
- ❖ Participants coming to center when sick
- ❖ Outbreaks for things that do not have as much guidance (ex. Lice)

Most Difficult Topics to Implement in ADCs



- ❖ Respiratory Hygiene & Cough Etiquette
- ❖ COVID Protocols
- ❖ Hand Hygiene
- ❖ Implementation and monitoring of practices that may happen at home (ex. devices & supplies)
- ❖ IPC Program
