ADC IPC Needs Assessment

LeadingAge Virginia developed a needs assessment to determine the capabilities for Adult Day Centers to implement the grant-developed resources.

The IPC Needs Assessment allows us to:

- ❖ Better understand infection prevention practices in place at each center;
- Better understand ADC's adoption of the grant-developed model infection prevention policies and related tools;
- Better understand barriers or challenges to effective infection prevention practices in each center; and
- Align LeadingAge Virginia's resources with any observed gaps in infection prevention practices and/or challenges reported by ADCs.

- Frequent policy and guidance changes
- Getting participants to use handwashing stations
- *Resources
- ❖ Staff + Staff Turnover
- Participants coming to center when sick
- Outbreaks for things that do not have as much guidance (ex. Lice)



Most Difficult Topics to Implement in ADCs




- Respiratory Hygiene & Cough Etiquette
