Dr. Kenneth Lee is a board-certified plastic surgeon at the Orlando Health Aesthetic and Reconstructive Surgery Institute. He specializes in complex reconstruction of oncological and traumatic defects in adults and pediatric patients and his expertise includes:

- Aesthetic surgery and rejuvenation
- Microvascular reconstruction

Dr. Lee also serves as Chief of Plastic Surgery at Orlando Health Cancer Institute.

He received his bachelor's and medical degrees through the Northeastern Ohio Universities College of Medicine BS/MD program in Akron. Dr. Lee then completed a five-year general residency with Orlando Health, serving as chief resident in his final year. He completed a second residency in plastic and reconstructive surgery at the University of South Florida Moffitt Cancer Center in Tampa, serving as administrative chief resident for three years.
