The National Lymphedema Network Expert Clinician program was developed to elevate the standards of therapeutic care being provided to patients with lymphatic diseases by implementing a live competency-based assessment on multiple facets of current lymphatic treatment. To qualify for this program, clinicians need to have been working in the field of lymphology for a minimum of five years, and maintain a caseload of patients with lymphatic disease for at least 75% of their regular schedule. If a clinician successfully passes the competency assessment, there are rigorous standards of continuing education to maintain the designation annually.
