

**Job Title:** MassDEP Wetlands and Waterways Circuit Rider (CR)

**Salary/Compensation:** The Annual Salary Range is from \$60,878 - \$88,727

**Location of position:** MassDEP's Northeast and Southeast Regional Offices. The CR's work schedule will be equally split between the two regions and their associated communities.

**Employer:** Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP), Wetlands and Waterways Programs.

**Description of employer:** MassDEP is the state agency responsible for ensuring clean air and water, the safe management of toxics and hazards, the recycling of solid and hazardous wastes, the timely cleanup of hazardous waste sites and spills, and the preservation of wetlands and coastal resources. The Wetlands Program oversees the state [Wetlands Protection Act](#) and its regulations. The Waterways Program oversees the [Public Waterfront Act](#) or [Chapter 91](#). MassDEP is an equal opportunity / affirmative action employer.

**Work schedule:** The Circuit Rider will work 37.5 hours per week and the schedule may include evening and weekend hours to accommodate the technical assistance, outreach and training responsibilities to local officials and others that is critical to the successful implementation of the position.

**General Job description:** : The CR should be adept at covering a wide range of subjects including: how to use the on-line eDEP forms, field plant identification and wetland delineation, stormwater control, guidance on municipal enforcement actions, exempt activities, site plan reading and interpretation, permit procedures, and guidance on how to assess project development issues for compliance with environmental performance standards. The CR is responsible for establishing regional municipal networks and has a working knowledge of related environmental laws.

**Qualifications:** Applicants must have at least (A) four years of full-time, or equivalent part-time, technical or professional experience in the field of environmental science, biology, chemistry, earth science, environmental health, meteorology, natural science, toxicology or public health, of which (B) at least two years must have been in a professional capacity, or (C) any equivalent combination of the required experience and the substitutions described in the MassCareers vacancy announcement link provided below.
