FY10 Geospatial

\$15-20M in FY10 for geospatial, excluding lidar/aerial

Regarding survey of geospatial market: they have only done a "full" geospatial, but hard number to get at. Perhaps look in to by NAICS code for FY10. Nancy could explore.

DHS \$30M in Lidar work

Discussion regarding "what is geospatial?" If MAPPS could supply them the particular NAICS codes, she could look into that.

Help define geospatial – give them some NAICS codes. **MAPPS ACTION ITEM**

Could mine the "Contracting Database" – remind Nancy **MAPPS ACTION ITEM**

AGC Military Terrain – contract was not QBS. Status?

Nancy: This was a contracting mistake & that language will be removed.

Army Mapper – specifically not A&E, reissued with fix

2011-12 Photogrammetry Manual update (to be contracted out)

Will have broad representation

2011 - \$20M in lidar

May get \$25 more if Continuing resolution (more than if not)

Flood Insurance Mapping Reform

NFIP reform – complicated pressures

\$17B in Katrina payouts

When flood maps change – can put people out of their houses

Administration proposed for comprehensive NFIP reform

Adopted minimum elevation data standard

Map by watershed now

National structure inventory – not historically supported by DHS because it seems cost prohibitive

Mostly reasonable (our policy statement)

Customer data services contract being released soon – will have:

- Web mapping elements

- Geospatial data management elements

Coming out very soon – 1-2 months

Current contract holder - Zaimerman & Associates (ZAI) has IBM on team

5 year contract expiring (originally map services contract)

\$10M/yr
