THE REQUEST

\$450 million in ARPA funds for 242 state housing authorities managing 43,000 units.

THE WISE CHOICE

Save and preserve what we have at \$10,500 per unit vs. replace at \$500,000 per unit.

CAN'T WAIT FOR THE NEXT HOUSING BOND BILL!

The need is immediate.

Bond allocations of \$55M annually are not enough to address the \$3B backlog.

OUTDATED FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS

Non-existent or outdated systems compromise safety and fire-fighting response times.

FORMULA FUNDING SHORTAGE

Shortage in the annual bond allocation due to COVID-19 related cost increases threaten planned capital improvements in the pipeline.

STALLED CAPITAL PROJECTS

Approved projects in the pipeline, including accessibility, plumbing and electrical systems, could be completed in 2-3 years instead of in phases taking 3,000+ units offline for 3-7 years.
