Clare M. Tempany MD, Awarded the 2019 MPCC Jack Colbert Memorial Award

September 3, 2019 (Boston, MA) The Massachusetts Prostate Cancer Coalition (MPCC) has announced that the 2019 Jack Colbert Award will be presented to **Dr. Clare M. Tempany** on September 17 at the Back Bay Harvard Club. The Jack Colbert Memorial Award is presented periodically to a distinguished individual in the medical community who has significantly advanced the fight to conquer and cure prostate cancer through research and practice.

Dr. Tempany is the Ferenc A. Jolesz MD Professor of Radiology at Harvard Medical School, Vice Chair of Radiology Research and Medical Director of the Advanced Multi-modal Image Guided Operating (AMIGO) suite at Brigham and Women's Hospital. The author of many research papers, she is a graduate of the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland, was a resident at Loyola University of Chicago and a Fellow at John's Hopkins University School of Medicine. Dr. Tempany is an expert in Body MRI and leads an active prostate cancer research group which encompasses basic research in image guided interventions and multiple clinical trials.

This award honors the late Jack Colbert, a founder of MPCC who worked to advance the fight against prostate cancer. Previous recipients of this distinguished award include Marc B. Garnick MD, J. Jacques Carter MD, MPH, Matthew R. Smith MD, PhD, Richard K. Babayan MD, William U. Shipley MD, Glenn J. Bubley MD, and Philip W. Kantoff MD.
