

Wadena County has an opening for a full-time Assistant County Attorney I or II. The Assistant County Attorney serves at the pleasure of the County Attorney and is required to administer and enforce the laws of the State of Minnesota and its political subdivisions. Areas of responsibility include criminal cases ranging from felony, gross misdemeanor and misdemeanor criminal prosecutions, as well as child protection, juvenile law, child support, and general civil practice. Assistant County Attorney I is a Grade 57 (starting salary dependent on qualifications) and pay scale range of \$30.48 - \$41.54 hourly, with annual step increases and a competitive benefit package. Assistant County Attorney II is a Grade 58 (starting salary dependent on qualifications) and pay scale range of \$32.00 - \$43.61 hourly, with annual step increases and a competitive benefit package. This is an at-will, full time salaried exempt, position working a minimum 40 hours per week but hours can exceed these minimums on occasion. Must be licensed to practice law in the State of Minnesota; strong preference given to attorneys with practical working experience in criminal prosecution and/or criminal defense, child protection, and trial experience.
