

Wadena County has an opening for a full-time Assistant County Attorney I. The Assistant County Attorney serves at the pleasure of the County Attorney and is required to administer and enforce the laws of the State of Minnesota and its political subdivisions. Primary areas of responsibility include felony and misdemeanor criminal prosecutions, with back up coverage duties to include juvenile law, child support, and general civil practice in all of the courts of the state. This position is a Grade 57 (Assistant County Attorney I) of the County Compensation Plan. Starting salary is dependent on qualifications, and **starting** pay is in the range of 27.02 - \$35.04 hourly (\$56,201.60 - \$72,883.20 annually), with salary step increases annually and a competitive benefit package. This is an at-will, full time salaried exempt, position working a minimum 40 hours per week but hours can exceed these minimums on occasion.
