**ORDER REGARDING PUBLIC HEARING ON
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO RULES 11 AND 14
OF THE GENERAL RULES OF PRACTICE
FOR THE DISTRICT COURTS**


O R D E R

The Supreme Court Advisory Committee on the General Rules of Practice for the District Courts recommended amendments to those rules, primarily in Rules 11 and 14, to address the submission of confidential records and data in court documents. On October 18, 2019, we opened a public comment period on these proposed amendments and scheduled a public hearing for January 29, 2020, directing those who wished to speak at the hearing to file a request to do so before the close of the comment period. One written comment; no requests to speak at the public hearing were received as of the close of the public comment period on December 17, 2019. Thus, it appears that a public hearing on the amendments recommended to the General Rules of Practice for the District Courts, as shown in the committee's report filed on July 31, 2019, is not necessary.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the public hearing scheduled for January 29, 2020, on the proposed amendments to the General Rules of Practice for the District Courts, that govern the submission of confidential records and data in court documents be, and the same is, cancelled.
