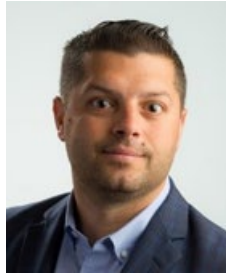

New Film Executive Co-Produced by Former FWA President Candace Straight

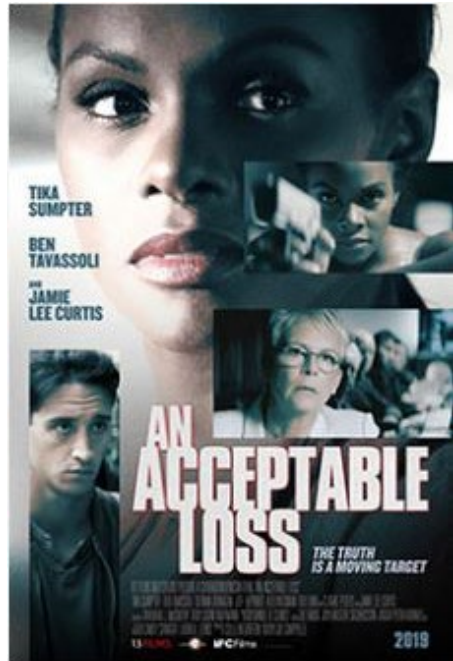
An Acceptable Loss, a film starring Jamie Lee Curtis and Tika Sumpter opens next week in NYC at the IFC film Center.

The IFC film center is at 323 6th Avenue and the screening starts at 7:30pm. Tickets are \$16 for Adults and \$13 for Seniors.



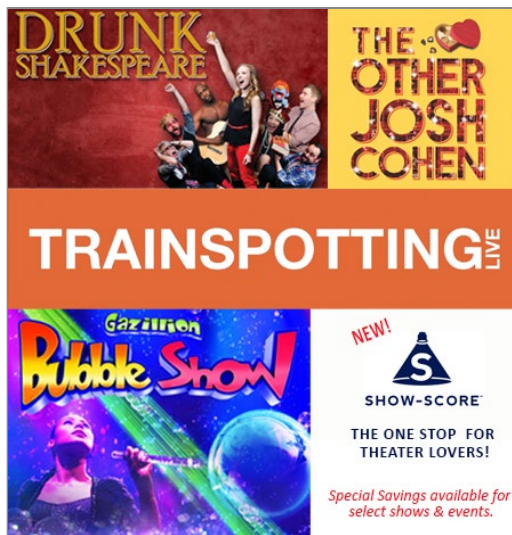
