A Resolution Proclaiming NAST Support for Financial Literacy Graduation Requirements for High School Students

WHEREAS The National Association of State Treasurers (NAST) believes in and supports the significance of financial literacy and financial empowerment for Americans; and

WHEREAS NAST believes financial education is a critical component of skills P-12 students need in order to become financially literate and financially independent citizens; and

WHEREAS NAST believes that teaching students to become financially literate through evaluating, analyzing, and utilizing personal finance practices that positively impact quality of life will position students for success throughout their career and adulthood;

THEREFORE, be it resolved that NAST supports financial literacy as part of an ongoing educational curriculum that includes a state-designated high school graduation requirement in each state in the United States.

This resolution is approved by the NAST Executive Committee and is subject to subsequent ratification or modification by the Association at its annual meeting in October 2019.
