The WOCN expects the content of this presentation to adhere to the following:

- Most Important: **NO trade names or logos** (including logos used for clinical trials) in slides or mentioned during presentation (e.g., use skin adhesive vs Dermabond™ or NPWT vs WoundVac™)
- Faculty must not actively promote or sell products or services that serve their professional or financial interests during accredited education (e.g., book sales, consulting services, logo or company contact information on slides, etc.).
- At least three references, current within the last three years, are listed in the educational materials.
- Permissions were obtained for the use of any pictures or other previously published material.
