There are 2 Health Centers near your district:

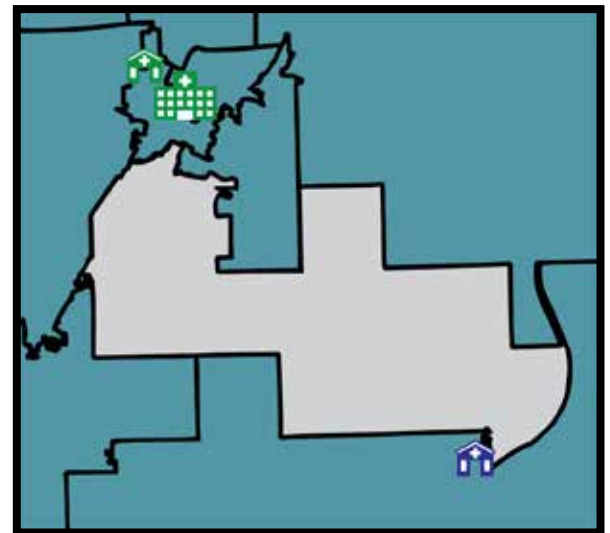
- **N.E.W. Community Clinic**

N.E.W. Community Clinic

Northeast Wisconsin (N.E.W.CC) Community Clinic, under the original name, Green Bay Area Free Clinic, opened its doors on July 27, 1971, as a UW Green Bay student's social work project. The N.E.W. CC is overseen by a volunteer community advisory board and administers ten programs; including Community Clinic program, Healthcare for the Homeless, N.E.W. CC at NWTC, and dental serving 14,000 encounters annually. Our mission is to provide access to quality, comprehensive, and compassionate health care to the underserved in our community. We have volunteer providers, along with a great partnership with our local hospitals and counseling therapists. When a patient walks through our doors we try to be a 'one stop shop' and work together as a team to ensure that health needs are met. We are also very proud that 59% of our patients stated that coming to our clinic prevented them from going to the ER.
