

Certification Standards

- A. Applicants must achieve a passing score on the TBE examination in order to be certified.
- B. Upon receiving a passing score, applicants will be issued a registered TBE certification number and issued a Certified Test and Balance Engineer Certificate.
- C. Certification is issued in the name of the TBE and the AABC member agency. TBE certification is only valid as long as the TBE works for a certified AABC member agency.
- D. TBE certification is renewable on an annual basis, based on the agency's record for the previous year, and conditional upon re-certification requirements for the agency being completed.
- E. TBEs must comply with AABC Bylaws, Policies and Procedures, Code of Ethics, AABC National Standards, and any other governing documents of the association.
