Maurice H. Roberts Award Nomination Form

The highest honor bestowed by the ET Seminar Committee is the prestigious Maurice H. Roberts Award. The Committee invites you to nominate an individual for the Award by completing and submitting the following form. You may submit more than one nomination. Maurice H. Roberts, namesake of this high honor, was an aluminum extrusion pioneer and one of the founders of the world-famous ET Seminars that take place every four years. The next Seminar, ET '24, will be held April 30 – May 2, 2023, at the Rosen Shingle Creek in Orlando, Florida, USA. Winner(s) of the Award, if any, will be announced at ET '24. In addition to Roberts, who won the first award in 1984, past winners include: Robert Werner, Werner Co. (1988), Roy Fellom, Light Metal Age (1992), Ivar Hafsett, Norsk Hydro (1996), Donn Sanford, AEC (2000), James Sanderson, Kaiser Aluminum (2012), Craig Werner, Kaiser Aluminum (2016), and Chris Jowett, Rio Tinto (2022).

Criteria: Established in 1984 and re-affirmed by the Committee during the next ET cycle, the criteria for identifying nominees and a possible winner of the award are:

- *Industry Impact* Nominees should have had a significant positive impact on the worldwide aluminum extrusion industry.
- **Teacher** Nominees should have a demonstrated track record of giving freely of what they've learned, so that others who follow may benefit.
- **Personal Contribution** Nominees should be personally involved and "not afraid to get their hands dirty."
- **Qualified** Nominees should have expertise that benefits the extrusion industry, though they need not be technical (e.g., Roy Fellom was a journalist.)
- **Leader** Nominees should inspire followers and be well-known in the industry.
