The Conference of Minority Transportation Officials (COMTO) was created to provide a forum for minority professionals in the transportation industry. COMTO's membership includes individuals, transportation agencies, private sector corporations, non-profit organizations, academic institutions, and Historically Underutilized Businesses (HUBs). When you join COMTO, you gain access to an exclusive international network of transportation industry professionals.

MEMBERSHIP TYPES AND BENEFITS

General Membership Benefits

Individual membership includes any person who is: 1) an employee or a policy board member of a public agency (transit agencies, airports, State DOTs, port authorities, rail companies, Metropolitan Planning Organizations, and local, state, and Federal agencies); 2) an employee of a business engaged in the transportation industry; and/or an employee of a business engaged in the supply of transportation goods and services; and 3) Individuals that have retired from a public agency, a business engaged in the transportation industry, or a business engaged in the supply of transportation goods and services who is not reemployed in the transportation industry are included in the definition of individual membership.

Student membership includes any person who is currently a full-time high school, graduate or undergraduate student with a major or a minor program of study in transportation, planning or a related field.

Academic institution membership includes colleges, universities, and vocational schools.

Nonprofit Organization membership includes 501c3's, 501c4s and 501c6's and Metropolitan Planning Organizations.

Private Sector and Transportation Agencies

Private Sector membership includes all firms that are a part of the economy which is not controlled or owned by the government that provide services to the Transportation Industry such as: 1) goods and services; 2) professional consultation services; 3) implementation services; and/or 4) professional management services. For the purposes of COMTO membership, Historically Underutilized Businesses are defined separately from private sector firms.

Transportation Agency membership includes any federal, state, county, or local agency that is responsible for commercial or public modal transportation service. These entities directly oversee transportation systems or impact transportation policy. Agencies in this category are located within the boundaries of the United States or its territory and possessions, Canada, or Mexico.

Historically Underutilized Businesses

A **Historically Underutilized Business (HUB)** is a business entity (i.e. corporation, sole proprietorship, partnership or a joint venture) formed for the purpose of making a profit in which at least 51 percent ownership, operation and control of the business is by a Black, Hispanic, Asian-American, American Indian, Female, Disabled or a Veterans-Disabled, or other recognized socially and Economically Disadvantaged person. HUBs include all firms that are a part of the economy which is not controlled or owned by the government that provide services to the Transportation Industry such as: 1) goods and services; 2) professional consultation services; 3) implementation services; and/or 4) professional management services. Dues for this group are reduced to assist small businesses who are certified as any of the categories listed in the first sentence. Gross sales or billings must be \$250,000 or less. If higher, the regular "Private Business" dues schedule prevails.
