The European Physical Society Gero Thomas Memorial Medal

Terms and Conditions

Preamble: The Gero Thomas Award is made annually by the European Physical Society for outstanding contributions to the Society. It commemorates the invaluable service to the European Physical Society given by Gero Thomas during his long term in office as Executive Secretary from 1974 to 1999.

- 1. This Medal in established in honour of Gero Thomas, Secretary General of the Association EPS from 1974 to 1999.
- 2. Nominations are invited from, and must be endorsed by, constituent member societies and EPS divisions and interdivisional groups, and Individual Ordinary Members; normally only one candidate will be expected from each constituent society and/or EPS division or interdivisional group or IOM.
- 3. The judges will be the EPS Executive Committee.
- 4. The winner will be an individual who has contributed very considerably to the European Physical Society.
- 5. The closing date will be decided by the Executive Committee. The announcement and the award of the Medal will be made at such places and times decided by the Executive Committee.
- 6. The medal may not be awarded to any person who is a current member of the Executive Committee at the, nor any person who has been a member of the Executive Committee in the past three years.
- 7. Nominations, limited to 4 A4 pages and accompanied by 3 supporters statements, should be sent to the EPS Headquarters in Mulhouse (for the attention of the Secretary General).
