# GBA Committee Gets Visit from Chief Meteorologist of Federal Agency

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) Sunny Wescott recently spoke at a meeting of the GBA Emerging Issues & Trends Committee as part of their Think Tank Series. Wescott is Chief Meteorologist of the DHS Cybersecurity and Infrastructure Security Agency. She spoke about the connections between the natural and built environments, climate change, and how infrastructure built decades ago was not designed to accommodate the barometric patterns seen today, leading to the potential for more frequent failures. One takeaway among many, according to GBA President Teresa Peterson, P.E., C.M.E., LEED AP O&M, ENV SP (*GFT*): "We need to be more creative when determining the impacts of projects, and comprehensive in our development and evaluation of solutions."

<u>National Dam Safety Awareness Day</u> is held every year on May 31 in memoriam of the more than 2,200 people who lost their lives in the failure of the South Fork Dam in Johnstown, Pennsylvania in 1889. It was the worst dam failure in the history of the United States.

We're proud that dam safety is a priority for GBA member firms and that we're able to play a role in safer practices.
