PSAI Invites Feedback on Standards for the Portable Sanitation Industry

(MINNEAPOLIS, MINNESOTA, USA, 23 March 2015) – The Portable Sanitation Association International (PSAI) is seeking feedback from providers, suppliers and consumers of portable sanitation services on two key initiatives. The PSAI's Code of Excellence for Portable Sanitation and three ANSI Standards for which the organization is the secretariat are currently in draft form and will be finalized over the next few months.

- **The Code of Excellence for Portable Sanitation** is intended to define what the best portable sanitation companies already do and what good companies are working toward. The intent is to educate the public regarding what they can reasonably expect from a good portable sanitation provider, and to help the industry serve customers better. - **ANSI Standards concerning sanitation in places of employment (Z4.1), sanitation for nonsewered waste disposal systems (Z4.3) and sanitation in fields and temporary labor camps (Z4.4)** have been available in draft form for several months. The documents are being updated for the first time since 2005, and the PSAI is seeking interested parties to form a consensus body responsible for finalizing the language. Draft copies are available free to PSAI members and for a nominal fee to nonmembers.

The PSAI will host a panel discussion concerning both these initiatives at its Annual Convention and Trade Show Scheduled for March 26-28, 2015 at the Gaylord Opryland Resort in Nashville, Tennessee.
