

AG Advice to a Chief on Religious Services

In response to a Chief's questions regarding "drive-in" religious services and whether a 10 person exception exists:

The Governor's allowance for religious services conducted in a drive-in/parking lot format is an exception to the 10 person limit so long as - 1) There are no more than 10 persons in a vehicle (unless all are from the same household); 2) there is Social distancing between vehicles; 3) individuals remain in their vehicles; and 4) the church/religious organization has no more than 10 persons outside of vehicles. My understanding is that formal guidance consistent with this advice is forthcoming from the Governor's office.
