

CHAPTER I

MEMBERSHIP

Section 1.01 CLASSIFICATIONS

C. Affiliated Medical Associations

Qualifications. Upon approval by a quorum of the DCMA Board of Directors, recognized medical associations, specialty societies, and other medical organizations comprised of physicians licensed in Miami-Dade County, and with their principle place of business in Miami-Dade County, are eligible to apply for Affiliated Medical Association status. Annual dues are determined by the Board of Directors of the DCMA.

Privileges. Affiliated Medical Associations shall have one collective vote on the DCMA Board of Directors. The voting member will rotate each year, based on the medical association's acceptance date into the DCMA. In the instance when the next organization in line to hold the seat on the Board of Directors is not available or interested, the seat will move to the next organization in line. They may attend any meetings of the Association which are open to Active Members and may serve and vote on committees established pursuant to Section 5.01 (III)(B). Upon approval into DCMA membership of 75% of the Affiliated Medical Association's physician members as paid, full Active Members of the DCMA, the annual Affiliated Medical Association dues will be waived. When available the facilities of the Association are available for meetings or seminars hosted by the Affiliated Medical Associations. Other privileges as approved by the DCMA Board of Directors may be made available to Affiliated Medical Associations as the Board deems appropriate.
