Please understand that these procedures are for the safety and the well-being of everyone who visits and works in our judicial facility.

G-1/SOUTH TOWER PARKERS

G-1 AND South Tower parkers will need to pass through the screening station established in the G-1 elevator bank or access a public entrance to participate in screening. Signage will be provided to remind you of this process.

HIGHLIGHTS

- Thursday, February 22nd is a full screening day. Subsequent days will be unannounced.
- Screening may result in short delays between 8-8:30 AM and 1-1:30 PM.
- Check your bags Metal may activate magnetometers.
- Have your courthouse badge visible as you approach screening.
- Place your keys, belt, and any items on your person in the basket available at the xray machine.
- All bags and purses must pass through the x-ray machine.
