MML STRIKES \$35 CAP DEAL ON POLE ATTACHMENTS

This week the House is expected to wireless antenna the deployment act on Third Read (HB 1991), sending the House version to the Senate. The bill saw floor last week amendments were taken to bring the bill in line with an MML compromise. The MML capped compromise pole attachments at \$35, addressed reasons to deny application for ROW usage, set application processes and timelines, and modified bonding requirements, among other issues. The Senate version is expected to come up for floor debate this week (SB 837). City Utilities of Springfield and Independence Power & Light continue to have discussions independently with wireless

carriers on their issues. MPUA addressed a letter to both the House and Senate last week, opposing the bill and supporting the exemption of electric poles from the bill as other states have done.

The prevailing wage bill (HB 1729) was perfected in the House last week on a vote of 86-63. It is a full repeal of prevailing wage. The Senate version (SBs 555 & 609) is on the Senate informal calendar and could come up for debate at any time.

A bill to repeal the municipal authority to prohibit private wells (HB 2216) was amended during floor debate in the House onto a bill related to the filling of county commissioner offices (HB 1442). The bill sponsor indicates he will see that the well language will be taken out in the Senate. The bill passed the House and heads to the Senate.

An ag bill (HB 1973) to exempt from Clean Water Commission permits non-point source discharges from ag runoff and irrigation return flows was rejected by the House Rules Committee on Administrative Oversight, and sent back to the Conservation Natural Resources Committee as being too broad. The bill was voted out of the Conservation Committee with a much narrower scope and sent back to Rules. MPUA participated in negotiations between ag interests and DNR on the matter to find compromise.
