Section 2013 of America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018 requires community water systems that serve more than 3,300 people to complete a risk and resilience assessment and develop and emergency response plan. HDR will talk through the requirements of the assessment. While EPA does not require the use of any standards or methods to complete the assessment, your utility is responsible for ensuring that it does meet the criteria in Section 2013(a) and (b). Learn what that means and how MPWC can help through materials in development.
